9. Matthew 4:1-11 tells of Jesus going out into the wilderness to be tempted after his baptism and before his public ministry began.  
\*Why do you think this happened in the life of Jesus?  
\*Why might God allow his children to be tempted or tested?
10. How did Jesus resist temptation? (Quoted scripture.) What scripture would help with a certain temptation?
11. How has prayer changed you?
12. What one idea stands out most to you in this 5 week series on prayer?
