1. Read and discuss the key passage of the message: Ruth 4:1-22
2. Discuss the central subject of today's message, "Leaving a Legacy of Redemption" and the four key points:

**God is concerned with the process**

**Redemption is going to cost someone**

**Faithfulness is highly honored**

**There is Power in Living in your Redemption**

4. Discuss the scripture verse Luke 16:10 "Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much."
5. Share your thoughts on the statement: "There is a way in which things work." –John Eldredge
6. Read James 1:19-27, what guidance does this passage give us in leaving a legacy of redemption?
7. Share your thoughts on the statements: "children are a gift"; doing things right requires Godly character; and "faithfulness is highly honored".
