7. Have you ever started a job without competency and had much to learn? Were you able to learn what you needed to learn? Do you know anyone you consider unteachable?
8. In what ways has humility served you in the work place?
9. What did you add to your employer or place of employment?
10. Did you grow up with a work ethic?
11. Were you from a family that worked together and then played together?
12. What is a specific time you felt joy because of a job well done?

Bonus (a Mike and Mandy question): In what ways have 18-30 year olds impacted your life? How can or do you mindfully impact their lives in a positive way?
