1. What are the four feelings or reactions to the Creed that Ted mentioned? Hint: they all start with F. (**Fun, fond memories, frustration, and foundation**).
 - Which label best fits you (or name a feeling about the Creed Series not mentioned)?

2. “He ascended to heaven . . . And sits on the right hand of the Father almighty.”
 - “Sits” is present tense, how do you picture this idea in your mind today?

3. Tell about a time that you went home after a long absence.
 - How do you think Jesus reacted to his home going after his time on earth?

4. According to Romans 8:34 what is Jesus doing at “the right hand of God.” (**Interceding for us.**)
 - Do you need him to intercede for you or someone you know today?
 - What does it mean to you that he is interceding on your behalf?

5. In John 14, Jesus says we should not let our hearts be troubled because he is going “to prepare a place for us” and is coming back to take us there to be with him.
 - How does this statement of Jesus calm our troubled hearts?
 - Can you think of a time his statement has calmed your troubled heart?

6. A professor in a Christian college displayed a sign in his classroom that said: “Perhaps today.” It was in reference to and in anticipation of Christ’s return.
 - Do you think very often about the return of Christ?
 - Would you say you’re eagerly awaiting it?
 - How do you imagine Christ’s return?
 - How would thinking “Perhaps Today” as you go through each day affect you?

7. Read Matthew 25:31-40 and tell the kinds of things the sheep do that show they are God’s people who will have eternal life.
 - In what ways have you and your congregation done these things?
 - Is there any other way to interpret this passage?

8. “The King will reply, ‘I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.’”
 - Whom do you know who might be considered “the least of these”?

9. What are your hopes for heaven? What are you anxiously anticipating?
