1. What are the seven things the Lord hates according to Proverbs 6:16-19? (**Haughty eyes, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked schemes, feet that are quick to rush into evil, a false witness who pours out lies and a person who stirs up conflict in the community.**)

2. John Piper says, “Surely the blood of the unborn is as innocent as any blood that flows in the world.” When Solomon wrote his proverbs, whom do you think he might have had in mind besides the unborn when he said the Lord hates “hands that shed innocent blood?”

3. Psalm 139:14 praises God because mankind is “fearfully and wonderfully made.” What amazes you the most about the way we humans are made?

4. Psalms 139:16 says, “Your eyes saw my unformed body; all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.” What do you think the poet/psalmist is saying about our days?

5. Why do you think men have actually killed abortion doctors? Do you think the best way to save unborn babies is picketing in front of abortion clinics? What can we do that can make a difference? (**Ted mentioned Save the Stork, Options Pregnancy, offering to help monetarily, babysitting, etc.**)

6. What was the statistic given for how many women experience abortion? (**1 in 3**) Do you know someone who has had an abortion? Why? Were there any repercussions that you’re aware of?

7. What percent of abortions are matters of convenience? (**95%**) What kind of things do you think might make up inconvenience?

8. Do you know pro-choice people who would never consider abortion for themselves, like the lady who wouldn’t consider aborting her Down Syndrome son? Why do they feel pro-choice is the right policy?

9. Ted mentioned the 9/11 Memorial and a listing of the dead, which included “Renee A. May and her unborn child.” What other things are these unborn children often called in the cultural wars? What are some instances when unborn child is used and when other labels are used?

10. Why is it so difficult for Christians to let go of guilt and shame? How can we really experience the freedom that Jesus offers?
