 - *What would you say “I’m Third” means?
 - *How does this run counter to our culture?
 - *Did you often choose to be third this past week? Is it true of you sometimes or as a rule?
6. Joe’s daughter-in-law Jennifer changed the culture of Disneyland. Do you remember how? Do you know of others who have changed the culture of a place because they cared for others?
7. Do you agree that love is a decision? Why or why not?
8. How does living without “seeking self” contribute to unity?
9. How have others served you like Jesus served when he washed his disciples’ feet? How have you served others in that way?
10. Joe made an acronym out of family to close the service. What do the letters in family stand for? (**Forget About Me I Love You.**)
