

Deciding on the Resurrection

Read Matthew 28:1-6 and 1 Corinthians 15:4-8

The stone was rolled away not so Jesus could leave but so others could come and see that the tomb was empty. What specific evidence of Jesus do you see in your life?

Read Matthew 28:7-10

The hopeful response of those who would come and see would be to believe and worship. What is the difference between knowing about the Lord and knowing the Lord? Between knowing the Lord and walking with the Lord?

Read Matthew 28:11-15

The guards reported what had happened but then devised a plan to explain it away. Why would that be their response? What is a false narrative that you hear to deny and dismiss what really happened on that day? What is your response to those arguments?

Read Ephesians 1:19-20 and 1 Peter 5:8

We say we believe in the resurrection but sometimes we do not act like the power of the resurrection applies to us. What lie does Satan use to get you to deny the power of His resurrection in your life? Have you ever considered that believing a lie over the truth denies God's power?

Read Matthew 28:16-20

What keeps us from sharing the good news of Jesus with others? How can you get over that hurdle to go and tell others about Jesus?

Is there something God has been reminding you about over and over again? May this be the time where you acknowledge His power and embrace it for your life.

Remember....nothing can stop us from sharing the Good News!
