Read 1 Peter 3:8, James 1:19 and Romans 12:10

Make a list of the ways these verses remind us to approach others when we don’t agree on something. Why is it so important to take these attitudes into our discussions around money? What is the result when we don’t embrace these attitudes?

How have your childhood experiences influenced your views around money? Do you think these perspectives are healthy? Why can these habits and perspectives be so hard to change?

Read Proverbs 24:3-4

Why is it so important for your spouse to feel heard and understood when you are making decisions around money regardless of the final decision? How does conflict about money bleed into conflict in other areas of a relationship?

Read Matthew 6:21 and 33

Jesus spoke about money in 11 of his 29 parables. Why is money such a big deal to Jesus?

Finish your time praying for God to give you compassion, humility and conviction to take a look at how you are using the money God gives you. Go to Him with gratefulness for all of the ways He provides for you and excitement for the way He could use you in this area in the future.
