Part 6 – The Helmet of Salvation

Read Ephesians 6:11

Taking a stand for the Lord places you on Satan's radar. Who is standing in battle with you? Discuss any examples of those people who are or who have in the past, stood with you through spiritual battles. How did this make you feel?

Are you standing with others in their battle? If so, discuss those people who you are or have in the past, stood with in their spiritual battles.

Ted stated that *"the silence of our friends is harder than the accusations of the enemy"*. Do you shy away from standing with your brothers and sisters for fear of attacks from those who oppose the truth? How do you think this makes them feel?

Read Ephesians 6:17

Ted mentioned that the lack of clarity causes confusion. Why is this? How does the clarity provided by the word of God concerning our salvation give us Certainty, Confidence and Courage to "stand against the devil's schemes"?

Read 1 John 5:11-13

We need to know that we are saved. There is a difference between knowing about the name of the Son of God and believing in the name of the Son of God. What is the difference?

Read the following verses from what is commonly referred to as "Romans Road":

Romans 3:23, 6:23, 5:8, 10:9-10, 10:13

Are you reluctant to share the message of these verses with others for fear of their reaction? How does this reflect on our confidence in our own salvation?

Read 2 Peter 1:10-15 and 1 Thessalonians 5:10-11

How does reminding each other of the confidence we have in our salvation help us to "stand"?

End in prayer by giving thanks for the power and clarity that the gospel brings. Pray for the confidence and courage to stand with others in their battle regardless of the repercussions. Pray that God would reveal any areas where we can stray away from the simple truth of the gospel for our salvation and help us to be an encourager to those around us.
