Share an experience where someone took the time to teach you something? Was it a good experience?

Read 1 Corinthians 4:15-17

There is a big difference between telling someone how to do something and showing them how to do it. Does showing someone how to do something have a greater impact on the outcome? Why or why not? Are you willing to help others around you who are less experienced, especially in their walk with Christ?

In practical terms, what does it mean to be an example to other believers in conduct?

Paul stressed that our example is to other believers. What is the implication of this distinction? Do you tend to want to hold unbelievers to the same standards as believers?

Read 1 Corinthians 11:1, Philippians 3:17 and Philippians 4:9

These texts instruct us to imitate others. What are some important considerations we must think about when choosing to follow another person's example?

Read Philippians 1:27

This text challenges us to conduct ourselves in a manner worthy of the Gospel of Christ. What does that mean? How does what we do and what we don't do teach others about our belief in God?

How should we respond when a trusted person makes a mistake? When we make a mistake? What does our response when people mess up say about our understanding of Christ and the Gospel?

What does the way you are living today say about Jesus? What are some specific areas you need to grow in your example of Christlike conduct? Are you willing to ask someone else to help teach you?
