**'Til You Can't  
Love for a Lifetime  
May 8, 2022**

Who in your life has best modeled love?

**Read Proverbs 22:7 and Romans 13:8a**

When you bless someone (or do them a favor), is it difficult to overcome the feeling they are indebted to you? How about when someone does a favor for you?

**Read Romans 13:8b-9.**

As Paul quotes Jesus, is there any loophole remaining?

Do you have an example when you “loved” someone as you wanted to be loved instead of considering what made them feel loved?

**Read 1 John 4:15-16.**

How does simply acknowledging Jesus is the Son of God provide confidence we are abiding in God's love?

Why is it true that one of the best ways to determine if you love a neighbor is how you respond when they share good news?

**Read Romans 12:14-21**

How does abiding in God's love help us overcome the desire to get even with those who have wronged us or the desire to see them hurt like we have hurt?

How does this passage compare to the “shall nots” of the Ten Commandments?

**Read Romans 13:11-14.** The return of Christ is obviously closer now than when Paul wrote this passage. How do you “clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ”?

As you close, pray for each other that we may recognize the opportunities God provides to love our neighbors and that we may clothe ourselves daily with the Lord Jesus Christ.
