Ted said, "Our earthly father shapes a lot of what we believe about our Heavenly Father." How has this been the case for you?

Read Psalm 107:1-2 and Romans 8:38-39

Has there been a time in your life where you felt like God had abandoned you or simply didn't care? How do you remind yourself that God is present and that He will never leave you? How does knowing God is present change the way you react to the circumstances around you?

Read Psalm 107:23-32

How do you know when God is guiding you or when your own desires are leading the way? What are some of the ways we can ensure that we are hearing God's voice, especially in difficult times?

Read Matthew 7:9-10

Share about a time that God has provided for you in a way that was undeniably Him? Did that change your relationship with God?

Read Psalm 86:15, John 3:16, Isaiah 53:5, Psalm 103:11-12 and Romans 5:8-9

What do these scriptures remind us about God? Why is it easy to believe God is mad at us when we mess up? When we think of our kids (or when we were kids), have you seen that showing patience can be more powerful than discipline? How do we find the balance between the two?

Read Galatians 3:26

What are the thoughts that come to mind as you consider what it means to be a child of God?

End your time by thanking God for being a perfect Father. Ask Him to help us to remember the truth of who He is and to help us become more like Him. May we be a good representative of His love and care and may we be quick to invite others into His family.
