Alex said, “A monument is about the past, a movement is about the future.” How does this statement apply to the church? How can aesthetics be a part of mission? What can happen when we lose sight of why we do what we do?

Read Revelation 3:1-2

Why is it so easy to slip into the habit of going through the motions in your faith? What are some things you do when faith starts to feel dry?

Read Revelation 12:10-11

Are there areas of your faith are at risk of “falling asleep”? What are some of the subtle (or not so subtle) ways God has challenged you to “wake up”?

Read Revelation 3:3

When you realize that you have drifted, Alex reminded us to go back to the beginning and remember what God has done for us. Share some examples of times God has tangibly shown His love and care for you.

Read Thessalonians 5:2-3

We often think of repentance as something God demands when in fact it is an invitation for us. How does it change our perspective to see repentance as an invitation to closeness with God? Has that been your personal experience with confession and repentance?

Alex reminded us that our testimonies are not a marketing tool for growing the church but a spiritual weapon. What does this mean? If you have never shared your salvation testimony, be purposeful to look for an opportunity to do so.
